**W**e support parental choice in child care, and are committed to serving the needs of all of San Francisco's diverse communities.

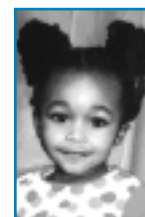

**ARE YOU A PARENT** who needs child care while you are working out personal or family problems that may put your children at risk?

**ARE YOU a guardian or foster parent** who works and needs child care?

If you answered “yes” to either of these questions...

You should know about Family and Children’s Services!

**YOU MAY BE**

- Homeless
- Enrolled in a drug or alcohol rehabilitation program
- Without income
- Struggling to make ends meet
- In school or in a training program
- A victim of domestic violence

... or in some other situation that demands serious life adjustments.

While you’re working things out...



**WE WORK** to find high-quality care for your child or children—and help you pay for it.

**IF YOU ARE** a parent, foster parent, close relative, or guardian,

**FAMILY and CHILDREN’S SERVICES CAN**

- Help you enroll in a child care subsidy program
- Assist you with documentation and payments
- Refer you to experienced providers who will meet your child care needs
- Offer necessary support and training to the provider you choose
- Give you information about parenting, schools, afterschool and summer programs, health, safety, and other useful topics

**WHO IS eligible?**

This program is designed for children who are receiving services through Child Protective Services in San Francisco. Your child welfare worker can determine if you are eligible, and how long you can remain in the program once you’re enrolled.

**IF YOU BELIEVE** that your child or children (or the children in your care) qualify for this program, please contact your child welfare worker at the San Francisco Department of Human Services.
